### *“For His Name’s Sake” – The Blessing of Sacrifice, Part Two*

1 Chronicles 29:1-9, 14-17, 20-23

#### **I. *The Sacrifice of David for the Glory of God’s Name***

##### A. Born of Vision – 29:1-2

- We are altar builders like Abraham – we come to see that sacrifices in the present secure blessings in the future.
- David – A vision entrusted to him, he expected to be part of its fulfillment:

*“I will not take what is your for the Lord or make an offering to the Lord that costs me nothing.” – 1 Chronicles 21:24*

- David knew the source of the wealth entrusted to him – 29:14-16

##### B. Bathed in Generous Joy – 29:3-5

- Was it a waste of wealth?
- Matthew 26:6-16 – the “foolish” outpouring of love.

- David prayed that this would be the perpetual attitude of God’s people

This act of sacrificial worship moved Solomon the Son of David to the throne of Israel; there was a transition in the kingdom. As we make our own sacrifices inspired by our great Savior, we too will see him enthroned among us – his kingdom extended in a new way.

- Let all the People of God give their all with great joy.
