Heavenly Worship – Part II: - Putting It All Together

Revelation 1:4-6; 5:6-14; 7:9-12; 19:5-21

- I. *Worship Is What We're Redeemed For:* 1:4-6**
 - A. Set Apart for Sacred Use
 - B. Offering Up Spiritual Sacrifices (which include ourselves)
 - C. In the True Temple – Church and Heaven

- II. *Worship Has Christ the Lamb at Center:* 5:6-14**
 - A. Holds the Scroll and Unlocks the Seals
 - B. Worshipped by ever-increasing circles of creation: thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.
 - Just as life was to flow from the first sanctuary-garden to fill the earth, so life flows from the throne of God to bring healing to the nations.
 - Movement from throne room to deepest ocean depth
 - This is Ordered Liturgical Worship

- III. *Worship Means We Draw Near to the Throne of Grace:* 7:9-12**
 - A. “Before the throne” and “Around the throne”
 - B. The song of the Redeemed: Salvation belongs to the Lord
 - A Brief Word about Music – discernment and dedication.
 - Heavenly Music/Sanctuary Music

- IV. *Worship Is a Command and Invitation:* 19:5-10**
 - A. The Present Imperative
 - An invitation to meet the President at his office
 - The sacrifice God commands from the heart he has redeemed
 - B. Christ the Bridegroom is our End and Goal

- V. *Worship Is Victorious Warfare:* 19:11 ff**
 - It is a war Christ wins, silencing his foes forever.
 - Psalm 110 – he reigns as King as he rules as Priest.
